It is designed to meet the criteria, standards and guidelines of the College of Dental Surgeons of British Columbia, College of Dental Surgeons of Saskatchewan, Manitoba Dental Association, Royal College of Dental Surgeons of Ontario, the American Dental Association and the Association of the Canadian Faculties of Dentistry for the teaching and administration of nitrous-oxide and minimum oral sedation. For a nitrous oxide/oxygen permit, the participant is required to attend the first two days. For an inhaled and minimal oral combined sedation permit, the participant must also attend the third day. Dentists are the only participants eligible for certification in this course. Prerequisites: Current Health Care Provider CPR Certification

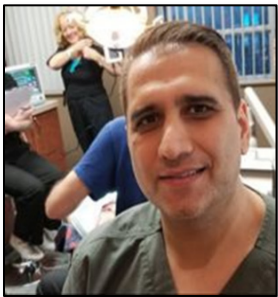
